This course is mainly focused on developing beginners' ability to understand spoken Te Reo Māori in familiar contexts and for them to be able to kōrero in a supportive environment. More capable learners will be able to extend their skills through learning to write proficiently in Te Reo, and/or Pānui/Reading Comprehension, in preparation for an external exam.
