



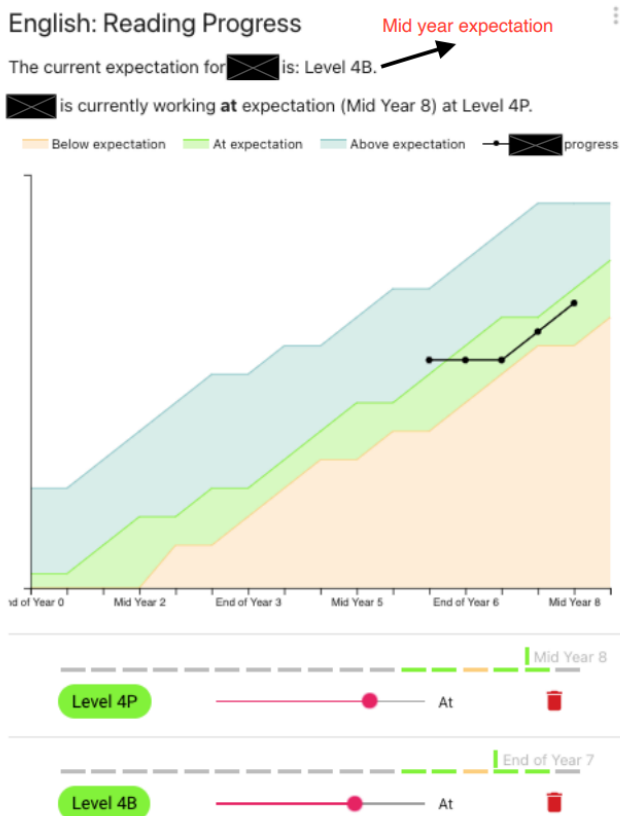
## Hikutaia School Newsletter Friday 1st July 2022

### REPORTS

This Friday the mid-term reports will be open on HERO. Parents will be able to read the General comments and see the achievement graphs for Reading, Writing and Maths. I have looked at the school wide data and am happy with the progress the school is making mid-year despite the disruptions we have had and the large absences from school. Below I have added a brief guide to what the grade and graphs mean.



### How to read the school report.

Teachers have made OTJ's (overall teacher judgment) on the best fit for your child against the NZ curriculum. You will see your child is at curriculum level **1,2,3,4,or 5** and either a **B** (beginning), **P** (progressing) or **A** (achieved). So if a child is recorded at **Level 3A**, that means they have achieved level 3 of the curriculum, and are now working towards level 4. A child working at **Level 3B**, they have just started working in curriculum level 3. Please note the "Current expectation level" is a mid year expectation level only.

### Kia o rahi/Tapu ae

On Monday our seniors will be competing in the annual Ki o rahi and Tapuwae tournament at Paeroa College. If you can make it down and see some of our kids in action, the games start at 9.30am.

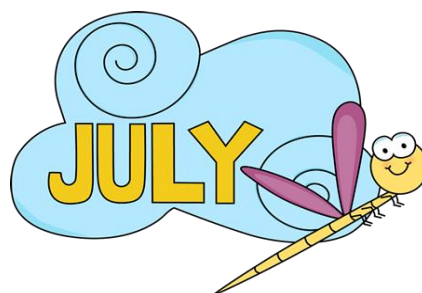
