This means the Executive Committee is now made up of Alice, Laretta, Penny, Marty, Kirsty, Bee and Courtney.

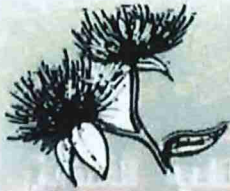
Bank Account Signatories: This remains as 2 out of 3 of Penny, Marty and Alice.

Principal's Report – Annual Report '22

The PTA continues to provide wonderful support for the children, teachers and families of Hororata Primary School. Our school relies upon the P.T.A to supplement the school's annual funding entitlement. The support afforded by the P.T.A has enabled the school to develop and implement many new and innovative teaching and learning programmes, maintain up-to-date teaching resources and undertake several property projects, enhancing and improving the school environment. The following information is a mere snapshot of the support provided by the PTA during 2021.

Active Culture...

- **Education Outside the Classroom...** Thirty-six Year 4-6 students participated in the Senior School "Bush" camp in Hanmer Springs in May. The experience saw our tamariki take part in a wide variety of challenging, yet rewarding bush based activities including tree climbing, mountain biking, bush survival skills, orienteering and swimming. Thank you to the Hororata Parent Teacher Association for their financial support, ensuring that all akonga had the opportunity to attend this camp.

Learning Culture...

- **School Resources...** The PTA contributed to the purchase of classroom consumables and sun protection.
- **Hororata kids have the gift of the gab...** The Hororata Speech and Poetry Competition was held in June. This year's theme was 'Community', relating to the school-wide collaborative theme for Semester One and included amusing renditions of well-known nursery rhymes; entertaining poetry and speeches about communities. Thanks to the PTA for providing the awesome wooden plaques to recognise the efforts of our akonga.
- **Parent Teachers Association Junior Cup...** Citizenship Awards are awarded to students in each age group relative to the contribution each child makes to our school during the school year. The Parent Teachers Association Junior Cup for citizenship in Years 1-3 was awarded to Layla Hay in 2021, with Merit Awards presented to Adahlia Tohiariki | Adaia Tohiariki.
- **Year Six Graduating Students...** Our school farewelled eleven graduating Year Six students at the end of 2021. The PTA gifted each of our Senior Leavers' Hoodie inscribed with their names at the end of Term One and partnered with the Board of Trustees late in Term Four, to host a special dinner for Year Six students and their parents here at school. The purpose of the formal dinner was to acknowledge and thank our Year Sixes and their families for the contributions they made to our school over the years.
