Final School Assembly:

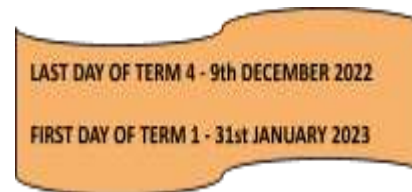
The final assembly will be on **Friday 9th December** at 12:00pm. **School closes at 1.00pm on Friday 9th December.**
