## SWAS Rafting Adventure

On the 23-24<sup>th</sup> of February, several South Westland Area School students and staff took a wild ride when they participated in the 'No Limits' TOSI Kahui Ako Rafting Camp. With generous funding from Sport Tasman, Pixie Manera-Maguire, Riley Manera, Carlos Schouten, Xavier and Levi Grimshaw were encouraged to "challenge their perception of what they are capable of." Run in conjunction with Inland Adventures and Jezza Williams from Making Trax, all food, rafting gear, and accommodation was provided to all participating students as their stomachs turned somersaults as they experienced adventure on the rapids.

On the first day of camp, SWAS students and accompanying adults Barney Young, Heather Abel, and Anton Grimshaw got a 9:00 am start to be ready to go at 11:30 on the Arnold River. Students spent the day on this grade two river enjoying the thrills and spills of the rapids while learning more about their gear and how to manoeuvre the rafts. Before the adventure began, Pixie shared, "We all got changed into our togs and put on the wetsuits, life jackets, helmets, special water shoes, and thermals, all provided by the camp." Students also played games to get to know all the other kids who hailed from Rai Valley, Sacred Heart, Karamea, and Maria Primary. After that, a yummy lunch, and a few interviews with reporters, the young adventurers were off.

Students stayed overnight at the Waituta Lodge, choosing to sleep in the lodge or camp out in tents. SWAS staff member Heather Abel shared her most fun moment being that evening "just listening to all the students talk about their day. They're like a little family," she smiled.

On day two of the camp, students rafted down the beautiful Māwheranui/The Upper Grey River, experiencing both grade two and three sections of the river called the Gentle Annie Gorge. They provided students the chance to challenge themselves further as they took in a remote part of the river, accessible only by the river, that features some spectacular scenery.

Joining students from Making Trax was Jezza Williams who, after a life-changing accident in 2010 which left him a tetraplegic, demonstrated to them that a disability does not have to take control of their lives, and he encouraged them to never stop pushing their limits. When asked if they enjoyed it enough to do it again, both Riley and Carlos responded with an enthusiastic, "Yes!"

The whole experience allowed students to think about their disabilities in a new and positive light and to consider how they can deal with challenging situations in the future, as a person's mindset can have a great impact on the success felt by each of us. Barney Young from SWAS had this to say about the two-day experience: "It was an opportunity to push themselves outside their comfort zone and experience a new challenge in our spectacular backyard. The trip was a huge success, which could be witnessed by the glowing faces on the students."

Buzzing like a drone,

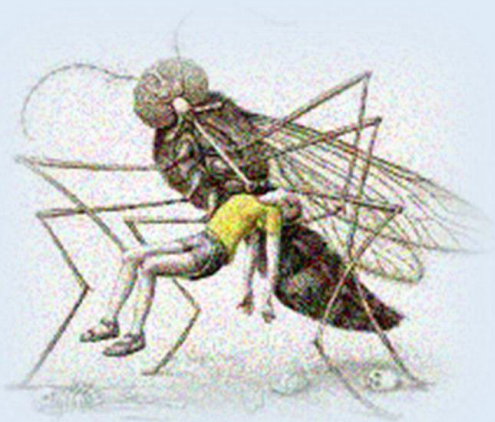
Never leaving you alone.
