

St Andrew's School (#3519)

Enrolment Scheme

Effective from 3 May, 2021

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under section 11G (3) of the Education Act 1989 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

Starting from the intersection of Waimate Highway (SH1) and Springbank Road

- West along Springbank Road to Campbell and Forrests Road
- West along Campbell and Forrests Road to Back Line Road
 - Including address 3292 Back Line Road
 - Including Robbs Bush Road
- North along Back Line Road to Blue Cliffs Road
 - Including Macaulays Road
- North East along Blue Cliffs Road to Davisons Road (also called Cocks Cutting Road)
 - Including address 7 Blue Cliffs School Crossing Road
 - Including McCalwees Crossing Road between Blue Cliffs Road and the Otaio River
- West along Davisons Road to Sidey Road
 - Including Davisons Road to Mt Buster Road, including Mt Buster Road
- South East along Sidey Road to Cairds Road
- North along Cairds Road to Lyalldale Middle Road
- East along Lyalldale Middle Road to Lyalldale Road
- North along Lyalldale Road to Pleasant Valley Road
- West along Pleasant Valley Road to Scotts Road
- North along Scotts Road to Pareora River Road
- South East along Pareora River Road to the Waimate Highway / Timaru-Pareora Highway (SH1)
- North along the Timaru-Pareora Highway (SH1) to Campbell Road
 - Including Sands Road and Pooke Road
 - Including Munro Road addresses to number 317
- From the Campbell Road / SH1 intersection, due South East to the coastline
- South along the coastline to a point due East of the Waimate Highway (SH1) / Springbank Road intersection
- West to the Waimate Highway (SH1) / Springbank Road intersection
 - Including addresses on Waimate Highway (SH1) between Springbank Road and Kohika Stream

Addresses on both sides of boundary roads are considered in-zone unless specified otherwise.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date that will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places that can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.
