

ST JOSEPH'S SCHOOL FUNDRAISING PROCEDURE



Education programmes are enhanced by the provisions of appropriate resources. In order to provide these, Government funds need to be supplemented.

PURPOSE

To provide teaching and learning facilities and resources adequate for the students to receive a quality education.

GUIDELINES

1. The Board recognises the School Community Group as a fundraising body for the school.
2. The School Community Group will consult with the Board on fundraising ventures.
3. The Board may approach the School Community Group to seek assistance with fundraising. In such cases the Board will consult with the School Community Group and staff in regard to how such funding is to be spent. The Board shall retain final approval as to the allocation and spending of any such fundraising.
4. The Board recognises that individual classes and school groups may undertake minor fundraising activities, subject to the Principal's approval. All incoming monies from these activities must be accounted for through the school office.
5. The Board will report annually to the community on all expenditure from fundraising and donations as required by the St Joseph's School Strategic Plan

CONCLUSION

Learning programmes and the functioning of the school should be maintained and improved by the addition of resources.
