TREATY OF WAITANGI PROCEDURE



1. The Board will engage with the local Maori community to gain an insight into particular needs and values. This can be done by student consultation, parent involvement, inviting Maori board membership and leadership.
2. The Board will provide opportunities for students to learn in and about Te Reo and Tikanga.
3. School programmes will incorporate Maori values and knowledge of Maori, in particular, local Maori.
4. The school will provide cultural experiences and recognise Maori needs with the use of Maori resources from within the community.
5. Staff development should include Te Reo Maori, Tikanga Maori and cultural sensitivity.
6. Through assessment, information and analysis and consultation, the Board will develop a Maori Achievement Plan with targets and therefore, will be able to implement programmes as required to develop achievement of Maori students and realise their potential and talents.
7. The school will provide a welcoming atmosphere for all parents and students by reflecting all cultures.
