### Scholarship Policy

#### **Rationale:**

The Waipara School Scholarship was founded by a long serving member of our Waipara community. The scholarship will be awarded to a Waipara School Year Eight student, with outstanding academic achievement, one who embraces our Waipara Learner Qualities, is the best that he / she can be and is heading off to secondary school education.

#### **Purposes:**

The scholarship provides \$500 towards secondary school related expenses and may be shared between recipients. The recipient will be chosen by the school staff.

#### **Guidelines:**

The student(s) receiving the scholarship will meet the following criteria:

- Achieve a Stanine 7 or above in standardised tests – PAT Listening, PAT Maths, STAR Reading
- Be above curriculum expectations in Literacy and Numeracy
- Have participated in extra-curricular activities – Science Fair, debating, speech competitions
- Share their knowledge with other students
- Be a leader and role model to others
- Be a good citizen
- Be the best that he / she can be
- Lead in his / her executing of the Waipara Learner Qualities
- An invoice, that relates to secondary school expenditure, must be presented to Waipara School by the family of the recipient(s) in order that payment be made.

#### **Conclusion:**

Waipara School is very fortunate to have received the funding for this scholarship and to keep the account in credit, all monetary donations made to our school (unless otherwise targeted) will be deposited into this account. The Waipara School BOT will also support this account with an annual deposit of \$500.
