WHĀNAU BUS INFORMATION 2021

Whāngārā School Board of Trustees are responsible for the operation of the Whāngārā School Transport.

Whāngārā School has two bus runs which are operated by Go Bus.

The Waiomoko/Panikau Bus run is paid for by the Ministry of Education and the Gisborne/Whāngārā bus run is funded from Whāngārā School operational budget with support from whānau.

Gisborne/Whāngārā bus run. Fees this year are as follows:

One child, Gisborne to Whāngārā-rtn\$15.00 per week. One or more in whānau \$25.00 per week.

Waiomoko Bus Run – Free.

Both these bus runs have guidelines and rules to ensure safety at all times.

This booklet outlines the student code of conduct and expectations that we have of all tamariki on the bus.

It is always difficult to manage the bus behaviour, so we rely on individuals to be responsible for their own behaviour and choices.

We also have bus wardens (senior students) who also manage behaviour and report to staff daily.

Please talk to your tamariki about safe behaviour and remind them about their behaviour. It is a privilege to be on the bus and it is important that the tamariki are reminded of this. Tamariki will be removed from the bus if they are displaying unsafe behaviour on the bus. Parents will be contacted by the school, and alternative transport to school will need to be organised by parents.

WHĀNGĀRĀ SCHOOL BOARD OF TRUSTEES BUS CONTRACT

Permission for School Bus (Whāngārā/Town)

- I give permission for my child/children to be transported from Gisborne/home to Whāngārā School return, daily.
- I will ensure that they will be ready for the bus at the correct bus stops.
- If I need to change bus stops, I MUST contact the school not the driver. The school must know any changes.
- I will contact the school if my child is not attending the school.
- If I have a concern as a parent, I must contact the school staff.
- I or any of my whānau must not discipline other tamariki for their behaviour on the bus. The school staff will investigate concerns and follow through with consequences.
- I understand that if my child's/children's not meeting the behaviour and safety expectations, while at bus stops or during transportation, they will not be permitted to use the bus service for a determined period of time. If the undesirable behaviour continues then they will be removed from the bus service. I will be responsible for my child/children's transportation to and from school.
- The cost for our whānau will be \$ per week. I will arrange direct credit/automatic payments with Admin (Koka Anthea).
- I understand that failure to make the payments will result in the withdrawal of my

child/children from the bus service.

A bus seating plan will be put in place and tamariki are expected to stay in their seats. We could change the bus seating arrangements if the need arises.

If there are issues with the seating plan, please contact the school or myself and we could look at making other arrangements.

Town whānau: please stick to one drop off/pick up in Gisborne. It can be too confusing if we have to change places for the tamariki.

If you really need to change plans, please ring the school and make sure that you talk to someone. Do not rely on leaving messages on the answer phone.

Student Code of Conduct Agreements are to be signed by the akonga and whānau. These forms must be returned to school ASAP.

Whāngārā School Bus Contract also needs to be returned back to school ASAP.

Please take time to encourage safe behaviour on the bus. It is a privilege to travel on the buses to and from kura and positive behaviour is essential.
